



Track 3 - MASTER GROOMER

International Certified Master Groomer

The Purpose of this qualification is for learners to understand breed standards to an advanced level.

The learner must demonstrate:

Safe Handling and Styling to Breed Standard of a Non-Sporting Breed, (Bichon or Poodle in Utility Group) Sporting /Gundog Breed,

Terrier Breed. (Can include Schnauzer)

The Mixed breed can be in a style of your own choosing to suit the dog.

The Knowledge and understanding covers breed standards for Utility, Gundog, Terrier, Toy, Hound, Working and Pastoral groups along with understanding mixed breeds angulation and symmetry.

There are seven written papers, one for each kennel club groups taken from the Kennel Club Illustrated Breeds Standards Book, and one on mixed breeds, including Terminology, Points of a Dog, and questions about Canine General Knowledge.

Practical Exams – Utility, Gun Dog, Terrier & Mixed Breed - Time allowed - 2 hours for these Breeds, Score 86% or above to pass.

8 Written Papers – Utility, Gun Dog, Terrier, Mixed Breed, Hound, Working, Pastoral & Toy

Time allowed, 1 hour each paper, 100 questions. Score 92% "Open Book" to pass.

OR

Time allowed, 1 hour each paper, 100 questions. Score 86% "Non - Open Book" to pass.

All questions in the Written Exams taken from the Kennel Club Illustrated Breed Standards Book.

Answers to the questions will either be, True or False, or Breed Identification from Photographs
